5. Maynard Evans High School, Orlando – Roofing on the newly constructed high school.
6. Boca Ciega High School, St. Petersburg – Roofing for high school renovations and additions throughout the campus.
7. EnviroFocus Technologies, Tampa – Roofing for the new 200,000-square-foot, \$117 million lead acid battery recycling plant, which will be the only such facility in Florida and one of about 13 in the nation.
